- ♦ I will act in an honest and ethical manner when interacting with the public and providing dog related services.
- ♦ When handling my own dog, I will never conduct myself in such a manner that it will reflect poorly on C-WAGS or the sport of dog competition.
- ♦ I will strive to create a professional, yet friendly atmosphere in my ring.
- ♦ I will judge at least once every eighteen months and always stay involved and current with any changes.
